Do you want a family life, to be able to go out, pick up your kids from school and spend some quality time with them?

With NHUC this is exactly what you can do whilst being part of a team of local clinicians serving our community. We are looking for GPs to be part of our out of hour's team alongside our Nurses and HCAs

We are a Community Benefit Society which is **not- for-profit**. We provide services across North and North East Hampshire, Surrey Heath, Farnham, and cover over 550,000 patients. NHUC is very much a community, led by clinicians. Many of our team have been involved with NHUC for many years and bring a wealth of experience to help support our newer joiners. We have been temporarily based at Hook GP practice for approximately 18 months, since the beginning of the pandemic.

We need your help to continue providing this high quality patient focused service.

Benefits of being a self-employed GP with NHUC include:

- Availability of a **broad range of shifts** to suit all schedules and to fit around other commitments ranging from 3-6 hours shifts in the evenings to day shifts at the weekend and a 9 hour shift overnight if a night owl.
- You can **choose your shift types** – from telephone/video consultations, base clinics, home visits or a combination of these and options can even include triage shifts from home once you have carried out the minimum requirement of base shifts
- There are **no commitments** from you to do a fixed number of shifts per month which provides you with flexibility to work around holidays and other activities.
- We have **competitive** shift fees and offer a great working environment
- We can provide **reflective qualitative and quantitative feedback for appraisal and revalidation** via Clinical Guardian, our auditing tool. This helps to build a unique record of clinical competence for your records.
- We offer a **diverse** range of clinical case load as you would expect in typical general practice.
- There is **limited paperwork**; you can generally **walk away** at the end of your shift.
- We have **training & networking opportunities** with options to attend quarterly educational evenings to support CPD.
- Our service is a not-for-profit social benefit organisation that is locally run by clinicians with **strong local knowledge**



NHUC Sessions

We offer sessional positions to meet your needs and sessions that will fit around your family life and lifestyle. In turn this could mean less work and less stress for you! NHUC have the following types of sessions available on the rota:

- **Primary Care Centre/phone triage (PCC)** - On site, face to face consultations and telephone triage as needed. Our Primary Care Centre is fully stocked with drugs and equipment
- **Triage** - From our Primary Care Centre (as above) but with the possibility to be set up to triage from home
- **Home Visits** - With your own driver and car provided (we have up to six vehicles). All shifts of this nature have an expectation of assisting at base when no outstanding visits.

NHUC Offerings - Sessional Positions

- Pick up ad hoc sessions from our rota to fit around your lifestyle and work as little or as much as you like.
- Working as self-employed contractors

Sessional Doctor Rates are paid at £85-110 per hour depending on shift day/time with enhanced rates for Bank Holiday weekends
